MISSION

The mission of SCEN Ambassadors, according to position and opportunity:

- ❖ *To promote the importance of learning about China, and learning Chinese, in Scottish schools, colleges, universities and workplaces;*
- ❖ *To promote links between Scottish and Chinese education, culture and business*

STRUCTURE

SCEN SCHOOL AMBASSADORS

- ❖ LEVEL 1 **PANDA AMBASSADOR**

Any pupil who can demonstrate good work in Mandarin or additional involvement in China-related activities.

Any pupil who has chosen to study Mandarin, Chinese History, Politics, Dance or Music, or any other aspect of Chinese culture.

❖ **LEVEL 2** **TIGER AMBASSADOR**

Any pupil who has presented or performed at outside events: for instance, in other schools, at Rotary Clubs, or to pensioner groups.

Any pupil who has represented SCEN at outside events: for instance, at the Language Show Live.

❖ **LEVEL 3** **DRAGON AMBASSADOR**

Any pupil who has presented or performed at national or international events in order to promote Chinese language and culture: for instance, at the Cross-Party Group on China at the Scottish Parliament, at the Consulate General for the People's Republic of China.
